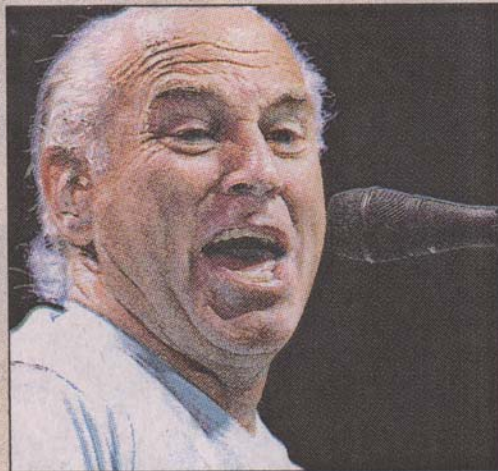
Main Event
